What You Will Do

During the Non-Election Season

2025 is a local election year in the City of Fredericksburg. During this time, you may be involved in the following tasks:

- Directing individuals to the Department of Elections website for candidate information
- Processing petition pages (you will receive training, and your work will be reviewed by a senior staff member)
- Assisting the public via telephone and in-person interactions
- Providing voter-related forms (e.g., voter registration, absentee ballot applications)
- Learning about the Virginia Code (§24.2)
 - o Reviewing election-related bills during the legislative session
 - o Discussing the legislative process in the General Assembly

- Helping plan and organize outreach events
- Attending outreach events
- Assisting with targeted outreach to voters aged 18–25
- Performing clerical and administrative tasks to support office operations

During the Election Season (Early Voting through Post-Election)

- Assisting with voter check-in and curbside voting
- Preparing materials for the precincts
- · Attending voter outreach events
- Answering phone calls and assisting voters with basic inquiries, including:
 - o Early voting dates, locations, and hours
 - Verifying if an address is within the City of Fredericksburg
 - Providing information about early voting locations in Spotsylvania and Stafford Counties
- Assisting the Absentee Coordinator as needed
- Transferring calls as necessary
- Visiting precincts on Election Day
- Performing any other duties assigned by the General Registrar to enhance your understanding of the electoral process

Additional Information

- You will be required to take an Oath of Office.
- You will be assigned a temporary email address and granted limited access to the state system.
