Professional organizations and methods to monitor student progress and analyze student data will be introduced. Field experience required. Writing Intensive Course. Cross-listed as EDCI 553 – The Teaching of English and Theater Arts.

As the COE prepares for national accreditation, we have been analyzing data gathered from our internship evaluations, mentor teacher evaluations, exit surveys, alumni surveys and administrator surveys and have found consistent areas where our candidates need to be better prepared. These are in the areas of data analysis and differentiation in instruction. We are going to add these needed areas in our Teaching Of courses. Furthermore, changes in state regulations call for increased skill for teachers in data analysis and assessment. The four-year path to licensure will not include a separate technology course, so we have added some of these skills to this course.
