REQUEST FOR REVIEW AND NOTATION OF POST-BACCALAUREATE MAJOR (Instruction Sheet)

This application is used for students who wish to complete a second major of study **after** completing a degree from UMW. The second major can be declared before or after graduation.

If you are a double major and intend to only complete one major before graduating, you must notify the Office of the Registrar that you plan to finish the second major after graduating and change your second major to a post-baccalaureate major.

Once your application is on file, a post-baccalaureate status will enable you access to a pin number for registration through your post-baccalaureate major advisor.

If you have not been enrolled at UMW for over a year, you will be required to fill out an **Application for Virginia In-State Tuition Rates**. This form can be found on the web at: http://academics.umw.edu/registrar/forms/downloadable-forms-for-non-degree-seeking-students/

Once the post-baccalaureate work is complete, your transcript will show that a postbaccalaureate major has been awarded. A second diploma **will not** be issued. If your original degree was a BA, you will not be able to change it to a BS degree for a BS major that was completed as a post-baccalaureate. If you want a BS degree, you must complete a BS major before graduation, so you may need to consider delaying graduation for a double major, rather than completing a post-baccalaureate major.

If you receive financial aid, check with the Office of Financial Aid to see if you would be adversely affected by graduating and then completing a post-baccalaureate major, rather than delaying graduation. You may not be eligible for financial aid as a post-baccalaureate student.

The top of the form is for your current contact information and your graduation information. The bottom of the form is for your post-baccalaureate information.
