	One 300-level ENGL, LING, or COMM elective course*	3

* Offered each semester.		
** Typically offered only in the spring. ENGL 470A has ENGL 304 as a prerequisite; ENGL 470C has ENGL 312 as a prerequisite. ENGL 470B (fiction) and ENGL 470D (multigenre) are typically offered only in the fall and have ENGL 304 as a prerequisite; therefore, it is usually not possible to complete the English: Creative Writing major with the capstone seminar in fiction writing in only four semesters.
