



A QUICK GUIDE TO SPRING 2021 CLASSES

EACH INDIVIDUAL CLASS WILL BE DELIVERED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING FORMATS

- OPTION 1 ➤ LEARN ON CAMPUS: *Lecture/Face-to-Face (limited offerings)*.** Classes will meet on campus at the days and times listed on your class schedule. Social distancing will be observed, each participant will wear a face covering or mask, and other safety measures will follow CDC guidelines.
- OPTION 2 ➤ LEARN ON CAMPUS AND AT HOME: *Hybrid with Online Work Synchronous*.** At the instructor's discretion, a portion of the class time is in person, on campus, at the days and times listed on your class schedule. The remaining class time is online as listed on your class schedule. Social distancing will be observed, each participant will wear a face covering or mask, and other safety measures will follow CDC guidelines.
- OPTION 3 ➤ LEARN ON CAMPUS AND AT HOME: *Hybrid with Online Work Asynchronous*.** At the instructor's discretion, a portion of the class time is in person, on campus, at the days and times listed on your class schedule. The remaining classwork is completed independently, online. Social distancing will be observed, each participant will wear a face covering or mask, and other safety measures will follow CDC guidelines.
- OPTION 4 ➤ LEARN AT HOME IN REAL TIME: *Online with Synchronous Meetings*.** The instructor facilitates live lectures and discussions in real time via Zoom at the days and times listed on your class schedule. Classes are 100% online. Some instructors may blend online lectures and discussions with independent online work, as indicated on the course listing.
- OPTION 5 ➤ LEARN AT HOME ON YOUR OWN TIME: *Online with Asynchronous Meetings*.** No online lectures or discussions will be held in real time. Students will work independently and must pay close attention to class deadlines for submitting assignments, tests, and other work. Classes are 100% online.

HOW WILL I KNOW WHICH COURSES ARE IN WHICH FORMAT?

Every course on the schedule has the instructional method listed: Lecture/Face-to-Face, Hybrid w/OL Work Asynchronous, Hybrid w/OL Work Synchronous, Online w/Synchronous Meetings, or Online w/Asynchronous Meetings.

You can browse courses based on instructional method. You can also view offerings in Banner Self Service, in which each course will be listed as online or lecture. Select the title to view the specific instructional method. You should read notes for each course by selecting "course description" in "class details."

After you register, you can choose "view registration information" in "schedule details" to confirm the instructional method.
